Betty was raised in North Carolina and grew up in a Christian family. She became a Christian at the age of 12. While she was in high school, her father was accidentally killed. This caused her to depend more fully on God for guidance and provision. After graduating from a Christian college, she spent a summer in New England working with the New England Fellowship of Evangelicals (NEF). She taught high school for one year and then worked as a rural Bible teacher with NEF for 6 years. The next phase of her life found her teaching school in North Carolina for 12 years and serving as the girls' program director at Camp Fair Haven during the summer. After her mother died, she felt led to work with Child Evangelism Fellowship and served as the Northern Maine director for 14.5 years. In 1992, she became the Southern Maine director for 6 years. In 1998, she retired from the position of Southern Maine director but had no intentions of retiring from serving the Lord and has continued to be available for training others and reaching children. She has relocated to North Carolina to be near to family members and is assisting CEF of North Carolina with teacher training at a church in NC and is leading 2 Good News Clubs.
